Persuant to Article 59 and Article 60 of the General Conditions for Works Contracts financed by the European Development Fund the section from Km 137 to 160 has satisfactorily passed the tests on completion on 02 December 2015.

A partial provisional inspection was carried out by the Contractor and the Supervisor's Representative and the works were found to be substantially complete as per Section 1210 of the General Specification for Roads and Bridge Works in Uganda and able to be used for the purpose for which they were designed, apart from minor defects and omissions. The works have satisfactorily passed tests on completion.

The works are taken over by the Contracting Authority with effect from 02 December 2015 and pursuant to Article 61.7 of the Special Conditions for Works Contract. The Defects Liability Period of 365 days commenced on the same date.

Description of the works handed over by the Contractor in accordance with the contract documents is as follows:

The section starts at km 137 approx. 100m before the beginning of Kabale town and continues to the

Katuna border crossing with Rwanda via Kabale town.

The partial acceptance comprise a length of 42 km, fully upgraded to a Class 1b paved road with 7 m carriageway width and minimum 1.5m paved shoulders. One original bridge at km 139 with span of 4.8m was replaced with a 2 cell box culvert 3*3m. Works on the main road consisted of widening the existing road in areas within cut or fill areas, in swamp areas and in trading centres where the width of the shoulders was increased to 2.0 / 3.0 metres. The works in Kabale included construction of a roundabout, pedestrian footways, drainage channels and a service road LHS. The longitudinal and cross drainage were improved by replacing existing culverts and the construction of concrete lined or stone pitched side drains. The existing pavement or improved subgrade layers (for widening and in cut areas) were stabilised to G45 specifications to form a 200mm subbase, 280mm crushed stone base (CRR quality), 90 mm asphalt concrete binder course finally surfaced with 60 mm asphalt concrete wearing course.
